Stewardship Moment

Ownership

God is the owner of all things. "The earth is the Lord's, and all it contains, the world, and those who dwell in it" (Ps. 24:1). We come into the world with nothing and leave it with nothing (Job 1:21; 1 Tim. 6:7), but God says, "every beast of the forest is Mine, the cattle on a thousand hills. I know every bird of the mountains, and everything that moves in the field is Mine" (Ps. 50:10-11). Everything we have, therefore, comes from Him (John 3:27; Jas. 1:17). There is no such thing as a "self-made man" -- "What do you have that you did not receive? But if you did receive it, why do you boast as if you had not received it?" (1 Cor. 4:7).

We may believe this truth in theory but deny it in practice. When this happens, we slip into the rebellious attitude that "My power and the strength of my hand made me this wealth" (Deut. 8:17). Instead, we must come to grips with the fact that everything we have in this world belongs to God and is only "on loan" to us. This includes not only our money and possessions, but also our families, careers, and plans for the future. If we can get straight on the principle of 100% ownership, we will be ready for the principle of 100% stewardship.
